3. He/she should be punctual for the lectures and practical as prescribed by the university.



2. Demand entry in the campus without identity card which has been issued by the institution.
3. Resistance occurred for the any students to take part in the academic, co-curricular, culture or extension activities will be treated as gross indiscipline that can invite action.
4. Usepossessing, buying or selling illegal drugs in the area of campus, like smoking products alcohol and tobacco.
5. Without any kinds of prior permission of Principal interacting with media, Commenting & posting derogatorily related to institution on social media, recording & providing audio, video clips in & of the campus.
6. In possessionof useof any fire, arm or lethal weapons or explosives.

7. In possession of or consumption of or distributed any intoxicating chemicals & drugs.
8. Involvement of any act of Ragging, Sexual Harassment, Violence in the premises of campus.
9. Involvement in the abetment or provocation or participation or organizing violent demonstrations or agitation or violent strikes.
10. Involvement in the abetment in the participating in any "gherao" or organizing violent agitation against any member of the teaching or non-teaching staff.
11. Theft of any property, documents or records of the institution or damaging it.
12. Involved in the gambling activity or organized it.
13. Without written permission from the Principal of the institution collecting or raising of funds for any charity, social, religious or political cause.
14. Involving in rumor's indecent conduct during the time of national emergencies, riot's and natural calamities.
15. Involve in any anti-National activities or knowingly supporting anti-national elements.
16. Involve in any act that amounts to crimes under the Indian Penal Code, Indian Procedural Code and/or all the Acts that are enforced by the Union of India and other State Authorities.
